Bavarian Archive for Speech Signals (BAS), LMU München License fees regarding BAS WebServices

- 1. **Academic Users**: The Web portal "BAS WebServices" maintained by the Bavarian Archive for Speech Signals (BAS) at LMU München can be used for free by all university affiliates and non-commercial research institutions ('academic users'); academic users are not required to obtain a user license; by using a service the academic user accepts the Terms of Usage for Academic Users as published on the Web pages.
- 2a. **Non-academic Users**, i.e. all users that are not covered by section 1, are required to obtain a non-academic user license according to the Terms of Usage for Commercial Users published on the BAS WebService pages.
- 2b. A BAS user license is **time and amount limited** (for details see the indivdual license agreement issued by the BAS together with the invoice).
- 2c. Non-academic users may access the BAS WebServices for testing without prior obtaining a non-academic user license but only with small data amounts and no batch processing.
- 2d. The **flat license fee** for one calendar month is Eur 50.- + VAT; the flat license fee for 12 calendar months is Eur 500.- + VAT; license fees are to be paid in advance; the flat license fee covers all services as published except services that involve ASR technique provided by a third-party provider (marked in the BAS WebServices interface); the latter are only accessible for academic users.
